(Editor's note: Because children 3, 4 and 5 years old are substantially less physically developed than a child 6 years old, the Honduras Government and Honduras educators established a shorter walking distance for kindergarten children than for elementary school children. As a result, certain kindergartens are not close to an elementary school. These stand-alone kindergartens must have a person who is responsible to the government and parents for operations of the school; these kindergartens must have a principal. Several of our schools have stand-alone kindergartens. To these kindergarten principals, performance is measured by successfully delivering children to 1st grade who are ready for 1st grade. The following story is from one such kindergarten principal.)

Dany is a 4 year-old boy that came from a family that was extremely poor (he suffered from malnutrition). Their neighbors recommended to his parents that they enroll him in school because that school was in the Lunches for Learning program. His parents were not so sure. We, the teachers, visited his house and saw what he ate - every now and then, a cup of black coffee and a tortilla. So, we as a (school) community explained to the parents that Dany would be given a better meal at school every day. The parents reluctantly did it.

Once Dany had been in school for a while, he was asked what his favorite thing about school was. He answered "the daily meal."

Now Dany is a fourth grade student who encourages his younger siblings to start and attend school. He acknowledges that if it weren't for the Lunches for Learning program, he would not have started or stayed in school.
